Parents Code of Conduct

I WILL:

- 1. Make soccer participation for my child and others a positive experience.
- 2. Be punctual.
 - (We understand that emergencies happen; please call the coach if you will be arriving late.)
- 3. Contact the Coach with absences.
- 4. Treat all players, parents, referees, and coaches with respect.
- 5. Support the team, coach, and the club.
- 6. Familiarize myself with the laws of the game.
- 7. Applaud good plays by our team AND by members of the opposing team.
- 8. Refrain from coaching on the sidelines as it can be confusing for the child and undermine what the coach is teaching.
- 9. Accept the results of each game, and encourage my child to: Be gracious in victory, and turn defeat to victory by working towards improvement.
- 10. Be a good sport win or lose.
- 11. Stay focused on our goal: To develop the whole player concentrating on the *POWER* Principles of excellence, desire, discipline and integrity while inspiring confidence, character and teamwork.
- 12. Discuss my child only with the coach, respectfully waiting 24 hours after a game to discuss your thoughts.

I WILL NOT:

- 13. Address the referee, opposing players, or opposing parents. DO NOT openly question the judgment of the referee and never his honesty. They all follow the same creed to call the game to the best of their ability.
- 14. Engage in any unsportsmanlike conduct.
- 15. Act in a manner that is detrimental to your child's team or FVSC POWER.
